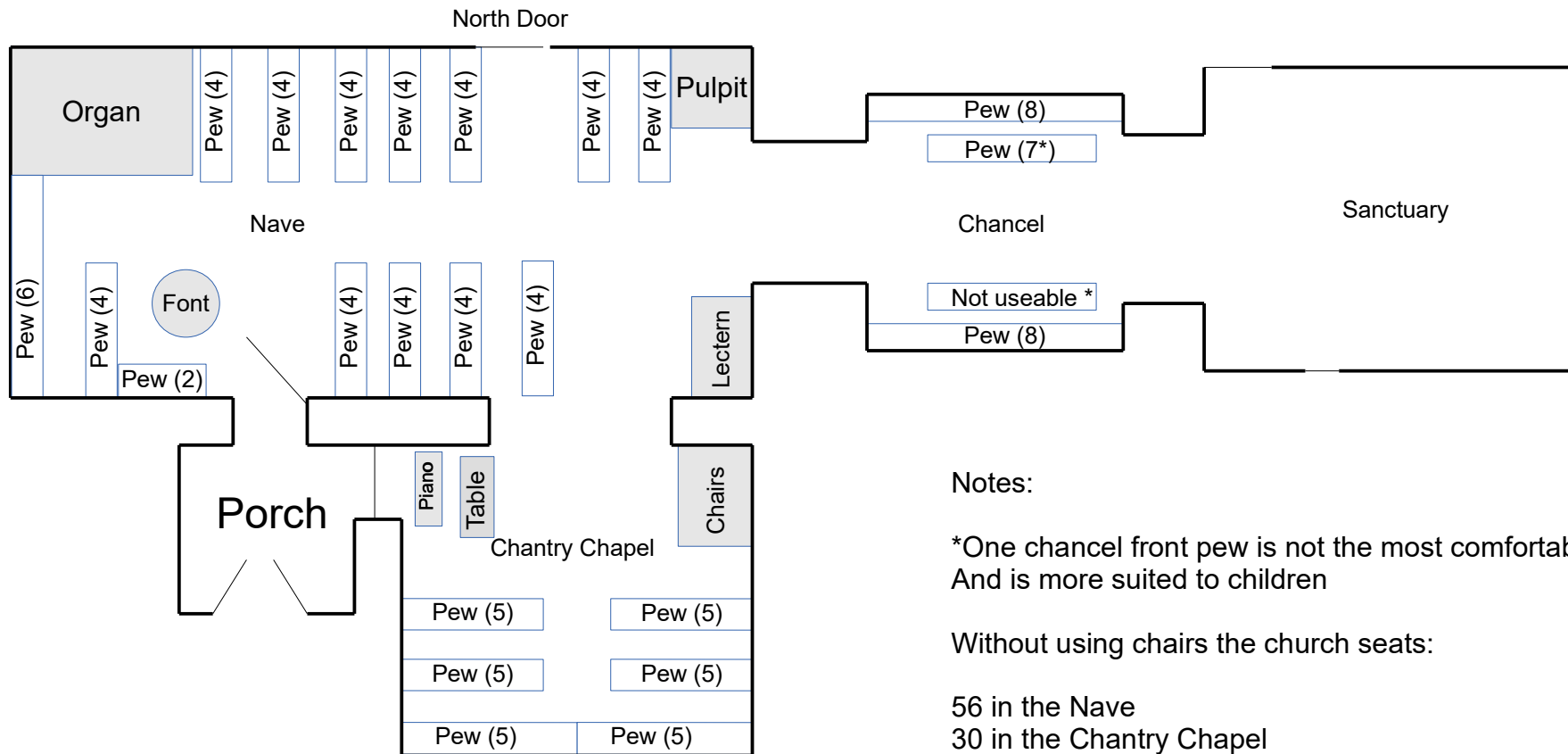


Lullington Church seating – without chairs



Notes:

*One chancel front pew is not the most comfortable
And is more suited to children

Without using chairs the church seats:

56 in the Nave
30 in the Chantry Chapel
23 in the Chancel
Total 109 (86 without using the Chancel)

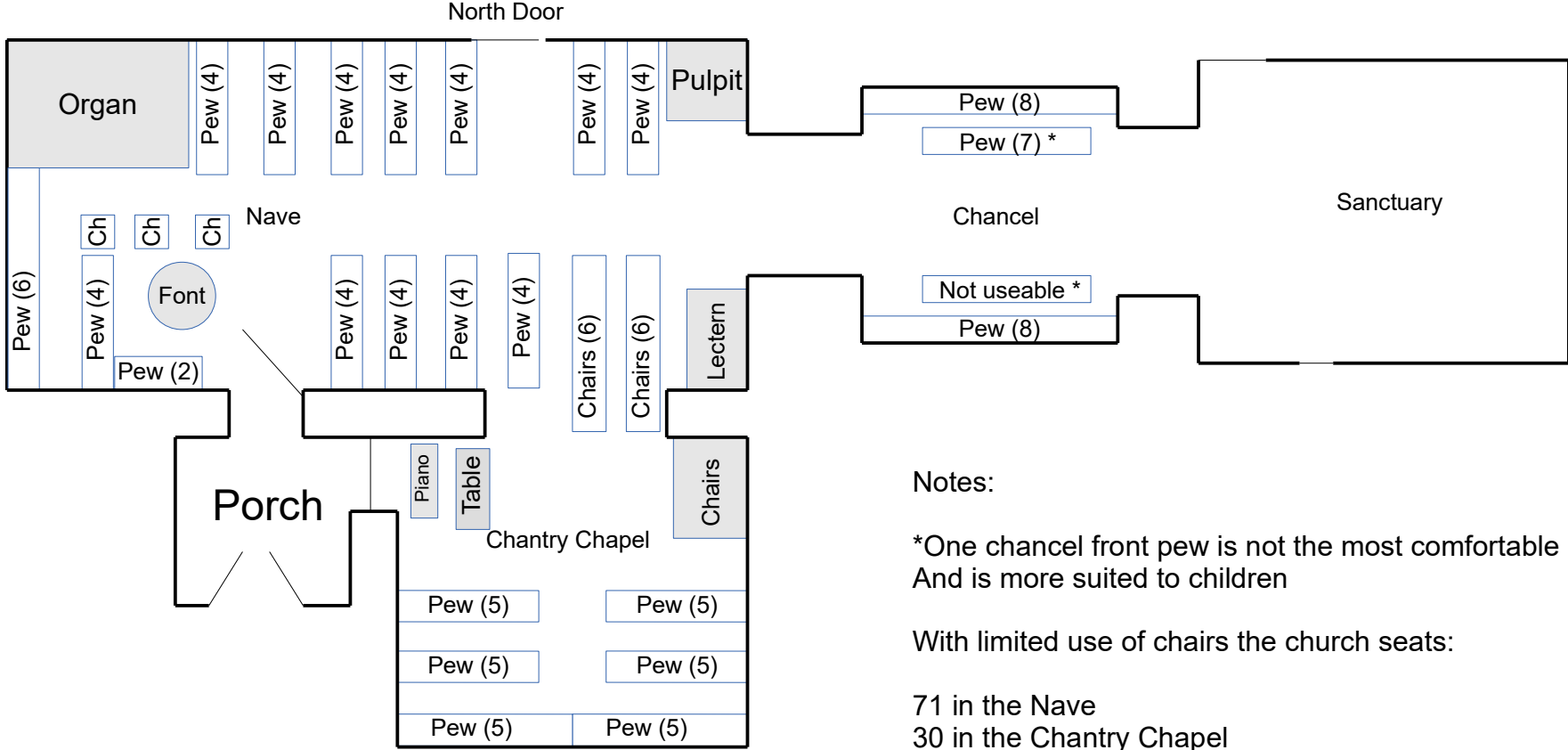
If there is a solo musician then the best place for them
to be is either near the lectern or by the organ

A string quartet is best placed by the font

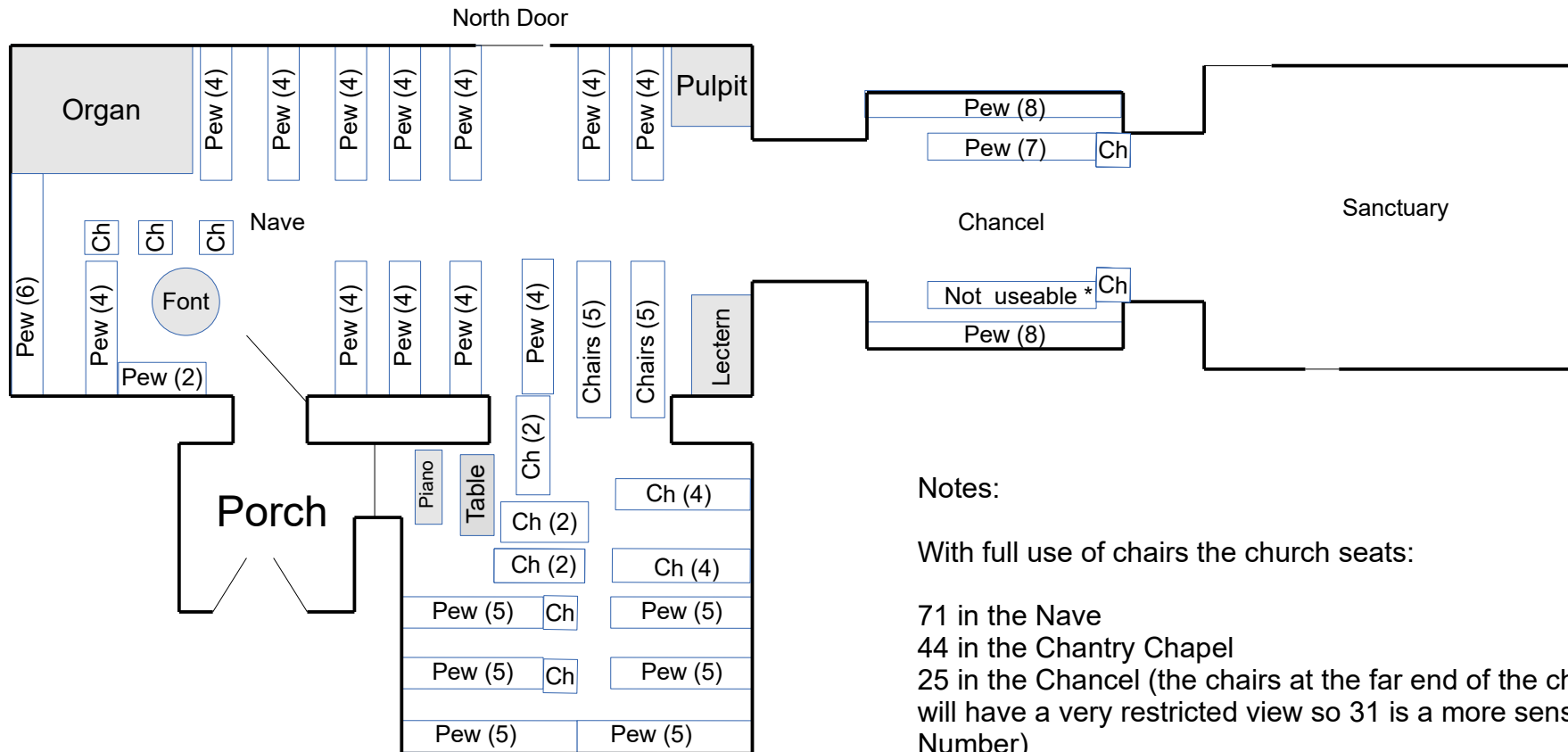
*One chancel front pew is not the most comfortable

With limited use of chairs the church seats:

- 71 in the Nave
- 30 in the Chantry Chapel
- 23 in the Chancel
- Total 124 (101 without using the Chancel)

With full use of chairs the church seats:

71 in the Nave

44 in the Chantry Chapel

25 in the Chancel (the chairs at the far end of the chancel will have a very restricted view so 31 is a more sensible Number)
